If the person killed is from people with whom there is an agreement between them and you, then pay the killed which is handed over to the family of the killed, and free a faithful servant. If a believer does not get a faithful servant, then he will fast for two consecutive months to accept repentance from Allah. And it is Allah is All-Knowing, All-Wise (An Nisaa': 4: 92)

"Allah does not punish you because of your unintentional oaths, but He punishes you because of your intentional oaths, so the kaffarat of that oath, is feeding ten poor people, namely from the food you usually give to your family, or giving clothes to them or freeing a slave. Whoever is unable to do this, then the kaffarat of fasting for three days. This is the kaffarat of your oaths when you swear. And keep your oaths. Thus Allah explains to you His laws so that you may be grateful (Al Maa'idah: 5: 89)

"O you who believe, do not kill game while you are in ihram. Whoever of you kills it intentionally, the fine is to replace it with livestock equivalent to the game he killed, according to the decision of two just people among you as had-yad brought up to the Kaaba or paying kaffarat by feeding the poor or fasting in proportion to the food taken out, so that he feels the bad consequences of his actions. Allah has forgiven what has happened in the past. And whoever returns to doing it, surely Allah will torture him. Allah is Almighty and has punishment. (Al Maa'idah: 5: 95)

In an effort to reveal the secret of Allah regarding fasting as proof of fear of Allah, fasting as punishment, fasting as payment, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid.

HYPOTHESIS

Here the author proposes hypothesis fasting proof of fear of Allah, fasting as punishment, fasting as payment, based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

PHOTON
