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ABSTRACT

"So when I have perfected what happened, and have breathed into him My spirit, then submit to him with prostration (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

"Then He perfected and breathed into him His spirit and He made for you hearing, sight and heart; you are very little grateful. (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

"And they ask you about the spirit. Say: "The spirit is the interest of my God, and you are not given knowledge but a little." (Al Israa': 17: 85)

"And Maryam bint Imran who maintains her honor, then We breathed into Maryam's womb Our spirit, and she confirms the words of her God and His Books, and she is one of those who obey.

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about how really was, the Prophet Muhammad saw was traveled by Allah, from the Haram Mosque to the Aqsa Mosque on the night of the 27th of Rajab, the 11th year of Prophethood, the author uses deoxyribonucleic acid as the basis.

HYPOTHESIS

PHOTON

Based on human Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA), it consists of 32.20% carbon atoms, 25.43% nitrogen atoms, 6.78% oxygen atoms and 35.59% hydrogen atoms. Where carbon, nitrogen, oxygen and hydrogen atoms are widely available around us and in the atmosphere.

The answer is in the secret behind the verse: "... We showed him some of Our signs...(Al Israa': 17: 1)

So, what exactly are "...signs of Allah...(Al Israa': 17: 1)?

The answer was "...Allah...traveled the Prophet Muhammad saw...(Al Israa': 17: 1) to use the room.

How to walk using the room?

Well, the method is to use the earth that is above the room.




Figure 12: Earth on a dynamic space.

Well, the earth is above a dynamic room, meaning that space can be affected by mass, force and energy. Or in other words the room can be curved, bent, spread and rolled.

As shown in Figure 12, the earth is above the space that is curved downwards. This means that the space under the earth is curved according to the shape of the lower part of the earth.

So, on the night of the 27th of Rajab, the 11th year of Prophethood, coinciding with the 11th of March 620 AD, the Prophet Muhammad was carried by Allah SWT from Al Masjid Al Haram to Al Masjid Al Aqsa with the intention of showing him some of the signs of the greatness of Allah SWT.




Figure 13: The room number 2 to the left to move to the right through a curved road leading to the room number 2 in a circle. As depicted in the picture number 14 below.

In figure 13 below, it is illustrated that the Haram Mosque is located in a place around the circle numbered 2 and Al Masjid Al Aqsa is located around numbers 1 and 2. On the night of 27 Rajab year 11 prophethood the room in places number 1 and 2 moves faster than the speed of light (speed of light 299 792, 458 km per second) towards Al Masjid Al Haram in circle number 2, see picture 14 below.

This, is proof, how the Prophet Muhammad saw on the night of the 27th Rajab year 11 prophethood coinciding with the 11th of March 620 AD was carried by the Prophet Muhammad saw by Allah SWT from Al Masjidil Haram to Al Masjidil Aqsa with the intention to show him some of the signs of greatness Allah SWT.

When Rasulullah SAW arrived at his house, the nature around Mecca was still pitch black and all the people around Mecca were still sleeping, but Rasulullah SAW had been driven that night by Allah SWT from Al Masjidil Haram to Al Masjidil Aqsa "...he had seen some signs -the greatest sign of God". (An Najm: 53: 18)




Figure 14: The room moves from the left of the number 1 curved to the right of the circle with the number 2 on up and headed back down to the circle with the number 2 again.




Figure 15: The room in the circle with the number 2 back moves to the left in to the room of origin in the number 1.
