In an effort to uncover the secret of Allah about how the Prophet Muhammad saw was traveled by Allah, from the Haram Mosque to the Aqsha Mosque, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid.

HYPOTHESIS

Here the author proposes hypothesis the Prophet Muhammad saw was traveled by Allah, from the Haram Mosque to the Agsa Mosque, using space, based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

So, the way to do this is to use the earth above the room.




Figure 1: The Earth is above a dynamic room.




Figure 2: Room number 2 on the left moves to the right via a curved path leading to room number 2 in a circle. As depicted in image number 14 below.




Figure 3: The room moves from the left of number 1 curving to the right of the circle with number 2 continuing upwards and heading back down to the circle with number 2 again.

In figure 2, it is depicted that the Haram Mosque is located around the circle number 2 and the Aqsa Mosque is located around numbers 1 and 2. On the night of 27 Rajab 11 prophetic years the rooms in places number 1 and 2 move at the speed of light (the speed of light is 299 792, 458 km per second) towards the Haram Mosque in the circle numbered 2, see figure 3.




Figure 4: The room in the circle with number 2 moves again to the left to the original room in place number 1.
