

UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS,

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ABSTRACT

"In Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm : 53: 14)

"Nearby is paradise in which to live (An Najm: 53: 15)

"when Sidratil Muntaka was overwhelmed by something that enveloped him. (An Najm : 53: 16)

"So when I have perfected what happened, and have breathed into it My spirit, then submit to him by prostrating (Al Hjr: 15: 29)

"Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing, sight and heart; you are very little grateful. (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

"Allah the light of the skys and the earth...the light above the light...(An Nuur : 24: 35)

"...We made the apostle an angel...We made apostle a man...(Al An'aam : 6: 9)

"And hasten to forgiveness from your God and to a paradise that is as wide as the skys and the earth prepared for those who fear Allah (Ali 'Imran: 3: 133)

"And We made before them a wall and behind them a wall, and We covered them so that they could not see." (Yaasiin: 36: 9)

"...has seen some of the greatest signs of his God (An Najm: 53: 13-18)

"His sight did not turn away from what he saw and did not go beyond it. (An Najm : 53: 17)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah SWT's greatness regarding Allah's secret about where actually is the Sidratil Muntaha visited the Prophet Muhammad saw when Mi'raj, the night of 27 Rajab, 11th year of Prophethood or March 11, 620 AD, the author uses deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) as the basis.

HYPOTHESES

Here the author proposes the hypothesis that the Sidratil Muntaha visited the Prophet Muhammad saw when Mi'raj, the night of 27 Rajab, 11th year of Prophethood or March 11, 620 AD, was on earth, based on deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure form a double helix and which contain polynucleotide macromolecules arranged together repeatedly from the nucleotide polymer. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5 carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. Nitrogen bases are Guanine (G), Adenine(A), Cytocine(C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) is composed of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 atom oxygen and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms, 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5 carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

So now, we continue to focus our minds on unlocking the secret behind the verses: *"...Muhammad saw Jibril at another time (An Najm : 53: 13) "At Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm : 53: 14) "Nearby is paradise in which to live (An Najm: 53: 15)*

Apparently, here, Allah has declared *"...Muhammad saw Jibril at another time (An Najm : 53: 13) "At Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm : 53: 14) "Nearby is paradise in which to live (An Najm: 53: 15)*

Now, the question arises,

Where exactly is Sidratil Muntaha?

The answer is in the secret behind the verse: *"...a paradise that is as wide as the skys and the earth... (Ali 'Imran: 3: 133)*

Well, it turns out that *"...a paradise that is as wide as the skys and the earth...(Ali 'Imran: 3: 133)* is located on this earth.

Now another question arises,

How do humans know paradise is located on this earth?

Well, because this earth is above the expanse of space called the sky. So, actually when humans talk about where the earth is, it is the same as the earth being above a stretch of space called the sky. So, there is the earth, there is the sky.

Or in other words *"In Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm: 53: 14) "Nearby is paradise in which to live (An Najm: 53: 15) is located on this earth.*

One night on the 27th of Rajab, the 11th year of Prophethood, coinciding with the 11th of March 620 AD, the Prophet Muhammad saw made Mi'raj to Sidratil Muntaha.

So, now another question arises,

Was there a veil between the Prophet Muhammad saw and Sidratil Muntaha?

The answer is in the secret behind the verse *"...We made a wall before them and a wall behind them...they could not see (Yaasiin: 36: 9)*

Well, it turns out that between the Prophet Muhammad saw and Sidratil Muntaha there is already a *"... veil... (Asy Syuura: 42: 51)* because the human eye's vision is limited, where humans can only see light in the electromagnetic spectrum area between 430 and 740 nanometers. Beyond that, the human eye cannot see light. Sidratil Muntaha lies outside the region of the electromagnetic spectrum between 430 and 740 nanometers. So, Sidratil Muntaha is invisible.

That is, because the Prophet Muhammad's eyes could not see light outside the electromagnetic spectrum area between 430 and 740 nanometers, then when the Prophet Muhammad saw entered Sidratil Muntaha, Prophet Muhammad saw could not see the situation in Sidratil Mutaha, because Sidratil Munataha was invisible.

The Prophet *"...Muhammad has seen Jibril...(An Najm : 53: 13)" At Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm : 53: 14)*

Now another question arises,

Why could the Prophet Muhammad saw see Jibril in Sidratil Muntaha?

Well, the answer is in the secret behind the verse *"...We made the apostle an angel...We made apostle a man...(Al An'aam : 6: 9)*

So, because Jibril is a man, a kind of human, the Prophet Muhammad saw saw Gabriel clearly.

Well now, in fact, the Prophet Muhammad saw did Mi'raj and met Jibril at *"Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm: 53: 14)* which is *"Nearby is paradise in which to live (An Najm: 53: 15)*, because indeed between the Prophet Muhammad saw and Sidratil Muntaka already exists *"...the veil...(Asy Syuura : 42: 51)*

How did the Prophet Muhammad saw know that the place was Sidratil Muntaha?

The answer is,

Kept in secret behind the verse: Prophet Muhammad saw *"...has seen some of the greatest signs of his God (An Najm: 53: 13-18)*

Well, when the Prophet Muhammad saw was at **Al Masjid Al Aqsa**, Allah had shown *"...the greatest signs... (An Najm: 53: 13-18)* that is like Adam when he was in paradise.

When the Prophet Muhammad saw was already in **Al Masjidil Aqsa**, then in that place Allah showed the Prophet Muhammad saw *"Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm: 53: 14)* that *"Nearby is paradise in which to*

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Also, when the Prophet Muhammad saw *"...saw Jibril...(An Najm : 53: 13)* , it shows that Jibril was *"...in Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm : 53: 14)*

Well, because *"Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm: 53: 14)* and the Prophet Muhammad saw already existed *"...a veil...(Asy Syuura: 42:51)*, then the Prophet Muhammad saw walked straight into the *"Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm: 53: 14)* which is *"Nearby is paradise in which to live (An Najm: 53: 15)* and the Prophet *"...Muhammad saw Jibril...(An Najm: 53: 13)* in *"Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm : 53: 14)*

So, actually, *"...Sidratil Muntaha (An Najm : 53: 14)* is on earth, near Al Masjid Al Aqsa.
