In Mina he threw the jumrah and then slaughtered the sacrificial animal. After that return to Mecca to perform Tawaf and drink zam-zam water. After the thawaf, he returned to Mina and stayed there until the 12th of Dhul Hijjah.

On the 13th of Dzul Hijjah, go to the Muhsab valley and rest for a while, return to Mecca, carry out the last thawaf.
