"And it is impossible for a human being, Allah speaks to him, except through revelation or behind a veil or by sending a messenger, then it is revealed to him with His permission what He wills. Indeed, He is the Most High, the Most Wise (Ash Syuura : 42: 51)

"From Anas bin Malik, the Messenger of Allah said: I was given a burqa, a white riding animal bigger than a donkey but smaller than a bighal..."

In an effort to reveal the greatness of Allah regarding Allah's secret about why the burqa ridden by the Prophet Muhammad saw, could enter the Sidratil Muntaha, near the Aqsha Mosque, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid.

HYPOTHESES

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

Based on human deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA), it consists of 32.20% carbon atoms, 25.43% nitrogen atoms, 6.78% oxygen atoms and 35.59% hydrogen atoms. Where carbon, nitrogen, oxygen and hydrogen atoms are found in abundance around us and in the atmosphere.

The answer is hidden in the secret behind the verse: *"...We made a wall before them and a wall behind them, and We covered them so that they could not see (Yaasiin: 36: 9)*

Well, here, Allah has put *"...a veil...(Ash Syuura: 42: 51)* between the Prophet Muhammad saw and Sidratil Muntaha.
