"... We made the apostle an angel... We made him a man... (Al An'aam: 6: 9)

And hasten to forgiveness from your Lord and to Paradise, whose breadth is as wide as the skys and the earth, which is prepared for the pious (Ali 'Imran: 3: 133)

"And We made a wall before them and behind them a wall, and We covered them so that they could not see." (Yaasiin: 36:9)

"So when I have perfected the scene and I breathed into it My spirit; then let you fall down prostrating to it (Shaad: 38:72)

"Indeed, for example, Jesus in the sight of Allah, is like Adam. Allah created Adam from clay, then Allah said to him: "Be", so he was. (Ali 'Imran: 3:59)
