ABSTRACT

The angel said:" Do not be afraid, we are (angels) aikat who were sent to the people of Luth. " Huud: 11: 70) "And when Our messengers (the angels) came to Ibrahim with good news, they said:" Surely we will destroy the inhabitants of this land (Sodom); actually the inhabitants are the wrongdoers. "(Al 'Ankabuut: 29: 31)" Said Ibrahim: "Verily in that city there was Luth." The angels said: "We know better who is in the city. We will really save him and his followers except his wife. He is among those who are left behind (destroyed). (Al 'Ankabuut: 29: 32)

"The messengers (angels) said:" O Luth, verily we are the messengers of your Lord, they will never be able to disturb you, so go with your family and followers at the end of the night and let no one be among you. you are left behind, except your wife. Indeed, the punishment that befell them will suffer because in fact, the time for which punishment will fall on them is at dawn; Is not that dawn is near? "(Huud: 11: 81)" And when Our messengers (the angels) came to Luth, he felt troubled because (their arrival), and (felt) did not have the strength to protect them. and they say: "Do not be afraid and do not (also) difficult. Indeed, we will save you and your followers, except your wife, she is among those who are left behind (destroyed)." (Al 'Ankabuut: 29: 33) "And the townspeople came (to Luth's house) with joy (because) the arrival of the guests. 15. (Al Hijr: 15: 67)

"Then the Angel (Jibril) called Zakariya, while he was standing praying in the mihrab (he said):" Verily, Allah pleased you with the birth of (your son) Yahya, who confirmed the words (that came) from Allah, followed, restrained himself (of lust) and a Prophet, including the descendants of the pious. "(Ali 'Imran: 3:39)

"And (remember) when the Angel (Jibril) said:" O Maryam, verily Allah has chosen you, sanctified you and exalted you over all the women in the world (who were with you). (Ali 'Imran: 3:42) "(Remember), when the angel said:" O Maryam, Allah will delight you (with the birth of a son who was created) with the sentence (who came) from Him, his name is Al Masih Isa son of Maryam. , a prominent person in the world and in the hereafter and including those who are drawn (to Allah), (Ali 'Imran: 3:45)

"(That is) when two angels recorded their deeds, one sat on the right and the other sat on the left. (Qaf: 50: 17)

Where in an effort to remove the veil covering the male angel speaking, I used a device called deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that an angel is a man who speaks like an ordinary human based on the basis of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information which has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules which are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. These nucleotides are composed of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine (A), Cytocine (C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) consists of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine (A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms, 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5-carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

THE ANGEL IS A MAN AND TALKING

Let us dig into the roots of what is behind the verse: *"And if We made him an angel, of course We made him a man and (if We made him a man), ... (Al An'aam: 6 : 9)*

It turns out that it is clearly illustrated to us that an angel is a man like us human men. Now if the angel is a boy how can he speak?

Now we dig deeper into the verse: *"And indeed Our messengers (angels) have come to Abraham with good news, they say:" Congratulations. "Abraham replied:" Congratulations, "... (Hud: 11.69)* and the verse: *"... The angel (Jibril) called Zakariya, ... (he said):" Allah will delight you with the birth of (your son) Yahya, ... "(Ali 'Imran: 3:39)* and the verse: *"The messengers (angels) said:" O Lut, verily we are messengers of your Lord, ... "(Hud: 11: 81)*

The more clearly it can be seen and read by us that angels are men who talk to Prophet Ibrahim, Prophet Luth and Prophet Zakariya who are also prophets who are men. What language do they speak?

Of course, use language that can be understood by angels and by the prophets.

So actually angels are men like humans like us men.

MEN ANGELS TALK WITH PROPHETS AND ORDINARY PEOPLE

Now the question is, can angels talk to prophets only and talk to ordinary people who are not prophets?

The answer is that Allah tells us humans that angels are human beings who talk to prophets and other human beings. Angels can see and talk with the prophets and angels can see other humans and on the other hand, humans with their own eyes can see angels.

We uncover the secret behind the verse: *"And the townspeople came (to Luth's house) with joy (because) the arrival of the guests. 15. (Al Hijr: 15: 67)*

Now here it is clearly illustrated that human beings in the area of Prophet Luth see and feel happy with the arrival of the angels. This is a proof that humans can see angels and angels can see humans.

ANGELS DO NOT EAT AND DO NOT DRINK THROUGH THE MOUTH

Actually, humans can live without having to put food and drink into the mouth. This means eating food and drink through a direct route inserted into the vein pathway which enters the blood directly. It is through this blood that all the nutrients needed by the body's cells will be distributed. Likewise with angels, as revealed in the verse: *"... then Ibrahim was not long after serving the roasted calf. (Hud: 11.69)" So when he saw their hands did not touch him, ... The angel said: "Don't you. fear, verily we are (angels-ma) aikat) who were sent to the people of Lut. "(Hud: 11: 70)*

So now it is evident that the angels eat and drink not through the mouth like our humans, but through a direct pathway into the vein pathway which goes straight into the blood.

ANGELS CAN TALK AND MEET ANYONE

It is clear now that the angel can directly talk to anyone, as illustrated in the verse: *"... The angel (Jibril) said:" O Maryam, verily Allah has chosen you, ... (Ali 'Imran: 3:42) "... The angel said:" O Maryam, Allah will delight you (with the birth of a son who was created) with the sentence (who came) from Him, ... (Ali 'Imran: 3:45)*

Now it is increasingly clear that angels are human beings who can talk to anyone. By using a language that can be understood by angels and by us as humans.

ANGELS HAVE MORE VIEW AND HEARING POWER THAN ORDINARY HUMAN

Where this situation can we unpack in the verse: *"(namely) when two angels recorded their deeds, one sat on the right and the other sat on the left. (Qaf: 50: 17)*

In accordance with the visibility and hearing power of angels, whatever is made and done by humans will be seen and heard by angels.

So even though the angel is not close to us, the angel can see and hear what we are doing and talking about. As is now happening in this technology, wherever we are, we can be seen and heard by others through information technology channels.

CONCLUSION

Based on the description above, we can conclude that an angel is a man like us ordinary male humans.

Angels are men who talk to Prophet Ibrahim, Prophet Luth and Prophet Zakariya who are also prophets who are men.
