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ABSTRACT

Previously, I asked for forgiveness from Allah SWT. Here I am trying to remove the veil covering spiders in relation to human beliefs from the point of view of the molecular structure of deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

There is one verse in the Quran that says the spider problem is associated with this human belief, namely:

"The parable of those who take protectors other than Allah is like the spider who makes a house. And actually the weakest house is the house of spiders if they know. (Al 'Ankabuut: 29:41)

HYPOTHESIS

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information which has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules which are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. These nucleotides are composed of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine (A), Cytocine (C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) consists of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine (A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms, 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5-carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

LIFE OF THE SPIDER DESCRIPTION OF UNBALANCED HUMAN LIFE

Let us open the secret in the verse: *"The parable of those who take protectors other than Allah is like the spider that makes a house ... (Al 'Ankabuut: 29:41)*
