DISCOVERING ALLAH'S SECRETS ABOUT LOVE IN PARADISE

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ABSTRACT

First, by asking forgiveness from Allah SWT, here I try to reveal the signs of Allah SWT regarding the secret of making love in paradise from the point of view of photons, quarks and the molecular structure of nucleic acids or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

HYPOTHESIS
