ABSTRACT

Previously the author asked forgiveness from Allah SWT in connection here I tried to reveal the signs of Allah SWT about the prophet Ibrahim and between his two wives based on the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that Prophet Ibrahim chose Sara as Sara, the first wife and descendant of the Jews, from the point of view of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. Now we reveal the secret behind the verse: *"...that's why Ibrahim was afraid of them. They said: "Don't be afraid", and they gave him good news with (the birth of) a pious child (Ishak). (Adz Dzaariyaat: 51:28)*

The incident described in the verse above is when the Prophet Ibrahim with his father Terach the prophet Ibrahim went out of Ur to Harran which is located on the border between Syria and Turkey.

After that the prophet Abraham and his wife Sarah went to Egypt, but Pharaoh took Sarah. When a disaster struck Egypt, Sara and the prophet Abraham were freed and were able to get out of Egypt and in Egypt the prophet Abraham got Hajar an Egyptian woman.
