EXPLORE ALLAH'S SECRETS ABOUT THE SCIENCE OF THE PROPHET MUSA THAT HAVE NOT REACHED TO THE TOP

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ABSTRACT

First of all, by asking forgiveness from Allah SWT, here I try to reveal the signs of the greatness of Allah SWT regarding the secrets of the science of the prophet Moses which has not yet reached the top from the point of view of the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

- "...when the two of them came to the inhabitants of a land, they asked to be entertained by the inhabitants of that land, but the inhabitants of that land did not want to entertain them, then both of them found in that country a wall of a house that was about to collapse, so Khidhr erected the wall. Musa said: "If you wanted, you would definitely take a reward for it." (Al Kahf: 18: 77)

In an effort to unveil the greatness of Allah SWT regarding the secrets of the knowledge of the prophet Musa that have not yet reached the top, I use the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that the science of the prophet Musa about what happened in society has not yet reached the top seen from the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)
