EXPLORE ALLAH'S SECRET ABOUT THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE WIFE WHICH IS BALANCED

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ABSTRACT

First of all, by asking forgiveness from Allah SWT, here I try to reveal the signs of Allah SWT's greatness regarding the rights and obligations of a balanced wife based on photons, quarks and the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

In the Qur'an, several verses are found that are the key to unlocking the secret of the rights and obligations of a balanced wife, namely the following verses:

"...And women have rights that are balanced with their obligations according to what is right. However, husbands have one level of advantage over their wives. And Allah is Mighty, Most Wise. (Al Bagarah: 2:228)

"And if a woman is worried about nusyuz or the indifference of her husband, then there is nothing wrong with both of them making real peace, and peace is better (for them) even though humans are miserly by nature... (An Nisaa': 4: 128)

"And if you are worried that there is a dispute between the two, then send a hakam from a male family and a hakam from a female family. If the two hakam intend to make improvements, Allah will surely give taufik to the husband and wife. Verily Allah is All-Knowing again All-Knowing (An Nisaa': 4: 35)

In an effort to unmask the rights and obligations of a balanced wife, I based on photons, quarks and deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose a hypothesis regarding the rights and obligations of the wife and the rights and obligations of the husband which are balanced from the point of view of photons, quarks and Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5 carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine (A), Cytocine (C) and Thymine (T). HUSBAND AND WIFE HAVE THE SAME RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

Let us together uncover the secret behind the verse: "... And women have rights that are balanced with their obligations according to the right way... (Al Baqarah: 2: 228)

Now, it is now revealed that in married life, husband and wife have equal rights and obligations.

That is, both parties, judging from the rights and obligations are the same, nothing is more or less. Even if there is one level of advantage on the part of the husband, it is only as the head of the household "... But husbands have one level of advantage over their wives... (Al Bagarah: 2: 228)

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS IN LEGAL, FINANCIAL, EDUCATIONAL, SOCIAL, FAMILY WELFARE AND PERSONAL RELATIONS ARE THE SAME BETWEEN HUSBAND AND WIFE

Now we explore the secret behind the verse: "And if you are worried that there will be a dispute between the two, then send a hakam from a male family and a hakam from a female family... (An Nisaa': 4: 35)

Well, it turns out that between the wife and husband have equal rights in legal matters.

If there are problems related to problems in married life involving personal, financial, educational, social and welfare relationships, they can be resolved through settlements between families through representatives from each party or through the applicable legal court.

PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP PROBLEMS BETWEEN HUSBAND AND WIFE CAN BE SOLVED PEACEFULLY

If we examine more deeply the secret behind the verse: "And if a woman is worried about nusyuz or the indifference of her husband, then there is nothing wrong with both of them making real peace, and peace is better (for them) even though humans are according to his miserly nature... (An Nisaa': 4: 128)

Now it is increasingly clear that in domestic life, the personal relationship between husband and wife determines the survival of the household. Neither party considers that what he is doing is good in terms of personal relationships. Such as indifference on the part of the husband, or vice versa indifference from the wife.

FINANCIAL, EDUCATIONAL, SOCIAL PROBLEMS IN FAMILY LIFE CAN BE SOLVED PEACEFULLY

Likewise, financial, educational, social problems in family life can be resolved peacefully, ...so it's okay for both of them to make real peace, .. (An Nisaa': 4: 128)

In financial matters, the wife as a housewife, then the finances are fully borne and guaranteed by the husband.

Likewise, if the wife works and earns income, then financial problems are guaranteed and shared together.

Furthermore, in the matter of educating children at home, husband and wife have the same rights and obligations to educate children at home, before the children enter school.

Likewise in matters of social life, between husband and wife have the same rights. Build networks, either through social media networks or direct networks in the surrounding community.

Based on the description above, we can conclude that the secret behind the verse: "... And women have rights that are balanced with their obligations according to the right way... (Al Baqarah: 2: 228)
