EXPLORE THE SECRETS OF ALLAH A LITTLE KNOWLEDGE, ACCORDING TO ALLAH, IS NOT THE SAME AS A LITTLE KNOWLEDGE, ACCORDING TO HUMANS

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ABSTRACT

"It is Allah Who created the seven heavens and the earth like it. Allah's commandments apply to him, so that you may know that Allah is All-Powerful over all things, and verily Allah has full knowledge of all things. (Ath Thalaaq: 65:12)

"And they ask you about spirits. Say: "The spirit belongs to my Lord, and knowledge is not given to you but a little." (Al Israa': 17:85)

"Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing and sight and hearts; you are very grateful. (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

In an effort to unmask the greatness of Allah SWT regarding a little knowledge, according to Allah, it is not the same as a little knowledge, according to humans I use the basis of photons, quarks and the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

HYPOTHESIS
