ABSTRACT

Before I write about the problem of pious deeds, a person is born because of the halal and good food he eats, the author first asks forgiveness from Allah SWT. Here I try to open the veil that covers the secret of a person's good deeds born because of the halal and good food he eats from the point of the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

There are several verses that become a means of opening the secret of a person's righteous deeds born because of the lawful and good food he eats, namely the verses:

"O apostles, eat from good food, and do righteous deeds. Verily, I know what you do. (Al Mu'minuun: 23: 51)

"Then eat lawful and good from the sustenance that Allah has given you; and be grateful for the favors of Allah, if you only worship Him. (An Nahl: 16:114)

"And eat lawful and good food from what Allah has provided for you, and fear Allah in whom you believe. (Al Maa'idah: 5:88)

"O you who believe, eat of the good things We have provided for you and be grateful to Allah, if it is truly Him you worship. (Al Baqarah: 2: 172)

"And Allah will increase guidance to those who have been guided. And eternal righteous deeds are better in reward with your Lord and better in their outcome. (Mary: 19:76)

"Those who were earlier, were first from the emigrants and the Ansar and those who followed them well, Allah is pleased with them and they are pleased with Allah and Allah has provided for them paradises in which rivers flow. forever. They stay in it. That's a big win. (At Taubah : 9: 100)

"And We did not make them bodies that did not eat food, nor were they eternal people. (Al Anbiyaa ': 21: 8)

In an effort to unmask the secret of good deeds, someone is born because of the halal and good food he eats, I use the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that a person is born because of the halal and good food he eats from the basic point of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5 carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine(A), Cytocine(C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) is composed of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine (A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms, 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5 carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

PIOUS BEHAVIOR

Now we are still trying to unravel the secrets that are hidden behind the verse: *"O apostles,... do righteous deeds... (Al Mu'minuun: 23: 51)*
