UNDERSTANDING ALLAH'S SECRETS, WHAT WE EATED, THAT'S OUR SUSTENANCE

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ABSTRACT

"It is He Who made the earth easy for you, so walk in all directions and eat of His sustenance. And to Him you will be resurrected. (Al Mulk: 67:15)

"Say: "Verily, my Lord expands sustenance for whom He wills among His servants and narrows it for." And whatever you spend, Allah will replace it and He is the best of sustenance. (Saba': 34:39)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about what we have eaten, that is our sustenance, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here the author proposes the hypothesis of what we have eaten, that is our sustenance, what has not been eaten is still not our sustenance seen from the basic point of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers.
