"So when I have perfected the event and have breathed into it my spirit; then you should fall down prostrating to him." (Shaad: 38: 72)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about what is wrong with blood, so Allah forbids eating blood, I use the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

#### **HYPOTHESIS**

Here I propose the hypothesis that blood is forbidden by Allah because blood is the source of human life, seen from the basic point of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

#### **DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)**

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5 carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine (A), Cytocine (C) and Thymine (T).
