ABSTRACT

I ask forgiveness from Allah SWT before continuing to reveal the secrets contained in the verse concerning the secret of Allah regarding the sacrifice of the submissive agreement between humans and Allah from the point of view of the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

Where are the signs of Allah's greatness regarding the secret of Allah regarding the sacrifice of the agreement of submission and obedience between humans and Allah which is written in the verses:

"When his Lord said to him: "Submit, obey!" Ibrahim replied: "I submit obediently to the Lord of the worlds." (Al Baqarah: 2:131)

"And We ransomed the child with a large slaughter (Ash Shaaffaat: 37:107)

In an effort to unveil the greatness of Allah SWT regarding Allah's secret regarding the sacrifice of the agreement to submit to obedience between humans and Allah, I use the basic molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that sacrifice is a submissive agreement between humans and God according to the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5 carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine(A), Cytocine(C) and Thymine (T). Guanine (G) is composed of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms.

Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms, 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5 carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

Based on deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) humans are composed of 32.20% carbon atoms, 25.43% nitrogen atoms, 6.78% oxygen atoms and 35.59% hydrogen atoms. Where carbon, nitrogen, oxygen and hydrogen atoms are widely available around us and in the atmosphere. These atoms are the raw materials for the manufacture of humans, animals, fungi, amoeba, plants, bacteria and archaea.
