UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS, ALLAH OPENS THE DOOR OF SUSTENANCE IN AN UNEXPECTED PLACE, IF HUMANS BELIEVE ALLAH IS NEAR INSIDE HUMANS

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ABSTRACT

Before the author writes about the problem of Allah opening the door of sustenance in an unexpected place, if humans believe that Allah is near in humans, the author first asks forgiveness from Allah SWT. Here the author tries to open the veil that covers the secrets of Allah opening the door of sustenance in an unexpected place, if humans believe that Allah is near in humans, based on the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

"It is He Who made the earth easy for you, so walk in all directions and eat part of His sustenance. And to Him you will be raised. (Al Mulk: 67:15)

"It is He who shows you His signs and sends down for you sustenance from the sky. And there is no lesson except those who return. (Al Mu'min: 40:13)

"To be a sustenance for the servants, and We bring to life with the water a dead land. That is how the resurrection takes place. (Qaaf: 50:11)

"It is He Who made the earth easy for you, so walk in all directions and eat of His sustenance. And to Him you will be resurrected. (Al Mulk: 67:15)

"So when I have perfected the event and have breathed into it my spirit; then you should fall down prostrating to him." (Shaad: 38: 72)

"So when I have perfected the event, and have breathed into it my spirit, then submit to it prostrating yourself (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

"Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing, sight and hearts; you are very little grateful. (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

"And when My servants ask you about Me, then surely I am near. I grant the supplication of those who pray when they ask Me, then let them fulfill and let them believe in Me, so that they may always be in the truth. (Al Baqarah: 2:186)

"Say: "Verily, my Lord expands sustenance for whom He wills among His servants and narrows

it." And whatever you spend, Allah will replace it and He is the best provider of sustenance. (Saba': 34:39)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about Allah opening the door of sustenance in an unexpected place, if humans believe that Allah is near in humans, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here the author proposes the hypothesis that Allah opening the door of sustenance in an unexpected place, if humans believe that Allah is near in humans, based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that form a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine(A), Cytocine(C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) is composed of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 atom oxygen and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms. 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5 carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

Here Allah declares "... Allah gives sustenance from an unexpected direction... (Ath Thalaaq: 65: 3)"... I grant the request of the one who prays when he asks Me... (Al Baqarah: 2:186)"...I am near...(Al Baqarah: 2:186)

Apparently, in Allah's declaration it is clearly described where if humans believe that "... Allah is near... (Al Baqarah: 2: 186), then Allah will easily "... provide sustenance from an unexpected direction...(Ath Thalaaq: 65: 3)

If humans really believe "...beg Allah...(Al Baqarah: 2: 186) that "... Allah is near... (Al Baqarah: 2: 186), then "... Allah grant the request...(Al Baqarah: 2: 186) directly.
