

UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS, ALLAH TALKED
TO THE PROPHET MUHAMMAD SAW, THROUGH
REVELATION, INDIRECTLY

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ABSTRACT

Before I write down the problem of Allah talking to the Prophet Muhammad saw, through revelation, indirectly, I first ask forgiveness from Allah SWT. Here I try to open the veil that covers the secret about Allah talking to the Prophet Muhammad saw, through revelation, indirectly, from the point of view of the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

There are several verses that become Allah's secret unlocking tool about Allah talking to the Prophet Muhammad saw, through revelation, indirectly, namely the following verses:

"That is part of the news and news of the land that We tell you about; among those lands some traces of it are still found and some have been destroyed. (Hud: 11: 100)

said: "O my Lord, judge justly. And our Lord is the Most Gracious, the Most Gracious, whose help is asked for in what you say." (Al Anbiyaa': 21:112)

"Indeed We see your face looking up to the sky, then We will indeed turn you to the Qibla that you like. Turn your face towards the Grand Mosque. And wherever you are, turn your face towards it. And indeed those who were given the Book do know , that turning to the Grand Mosque is true from their Lord, and Allah is never unaware of what they are doing (Al Baqarah: 2:144)

"And when Moses came for an appointed time and the Lord had spoken to him, Moses said: "My Lord, show me so that I can see You." The Lord said: "You will never be able to see Me, but look at the hill, then if it stays where it is you will surely see me." When his Lord appeared to the mountain, he made the mountain crumble and Moses fell unconscious. So when Moses regained consciousness, he said: "Glory be to him. You, I repent to You and I am the first to believe." (Al A'raaf: 7:143)

"And it is not possible for a human being with Allah to speak to him except by revelation or behind a veil or by sending an apostle, then it is revealed to him with His permission what He wills. Verily He is Most High. , Most Wise. (Ash Shuura: 42:51)

Allah said: "O Moses, verily I have chosen you and other humans to carry My message and to speak directly with Me, therefore hold fast to what I have given you and be among those who are grateful." (Al A'raaf: 7:144)

"And it is not possible for any human being that Allah can speak with him except by means of revelation or behind a veil or by sending a messenger and then it is revealed to him with His permission what He wills. Verily, He is Most High, Most Wise. (Ash Shuura: 42: 51)

"When I have perfected the event, and have breathed into it my spirit, then submit to it prostrating yourself (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

"So when I have perfected the show and breathed into it my skirt; then you must prostrate to him." (Shaad: 38:72)

"And We made before them a wall and behind them a wall, and We covered them so that they could not see." (Yaasiin: 36:9)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

"Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing, sight, and heart; you are very little grateful." (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

"And We put before them a wall and behind them a wall, and We covered them so that they could not see. (Yaasiin: 36: 9)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about Allah talking to the Prophet Muhammad saw, through revelation, indirectly, I use the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that Allah spoke to the Prophet Muhammad saw, through revelation, indirectly, because Allah decides with whom Allah speaks directly, from the point of view of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

DEOXYRIBONUCLIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide consists of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine (A), Cytosine (C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) consists of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytosine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms, 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. A 5-carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

ALLAH DOES NOT TALK DIRECTLY WITH EVERY PROPHET AND APOSTOLIC

Now, we are still focused on uncovering the secret hidden behind the verse: *" Allah said: "O Moses, indeed I chose you and other humans to...to talk directly to Me..." (Al A'raaf: 7:144)*

Well, it turns out, who decides with whom Allah will speak directly is Allah.

Now, the question arises,

Why doesn't Allah speak directly to every Prophet and Apostle?
The answer is,

Hidden in the secret behind the verse: *" Allah says: "... I choose... to speak directly with Me..." (Al A'raaf: 7: 144)*

Well, it turns out, who determines with whom Allah will speak directly is Allah.

Why doesn't Allah speak directly to the Prophet, Apostle or ordinary human being?

The answer is,

Kept in a secret hidden behind the verse: *"... I... have blown into it my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29)*

It turns out, indeed, Allah does not need to speak directly with every Prophet, Apostle and ordinary human being, because indeed Allah has *"...blowed into it my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29)*

So, Allah does not speak to every human being, because indeed Allah through *"... my spirit ... (Al Hijr: 15: 29)* which is in every human body, has spoken directly. Only humans themselves do not understand.

Allah, through *"... my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29) "...closer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)*

ALLAH DOES NOT SPEAK DIRECTLY WITH THE PROPHET MUHAMMAD SAW, AS ALLAH DIRECTLY DIALOGUE WITH THE PROPHET MUSA

Well, now, let's unpack the secrets that are hidden behind the verse: *"That is part of the news of the country that We tell you... (Hud: 11: 100)*

Well, here it is clearly illustrated, Allah spoke with the Prophet Muhammad saw, through revelation, meaning through messengers or angels, *"...what We tell you... (Hud: 11: 100)*

Likewise, when the Prophet Muhammad saw asked Allah *"said: "O my Lord, judge with justice. And our Lord is the Most Gracious, the Most Gracious, whose help is asked for in what you say." (Al Anbiyaa': 21:112)*

Where the Prophet Muhammad saw asked Allah, indirectly, through dialogue, as the Prophet Moses.

Now, for Allah, it is the same, whether Allah speaks or dialogues directly with the Prophets or not, because, even though Allah speaks directly with the Prophets, Allah needs an interpreter *"... My spirit... (Al Hijr: 15 : 29) .*

Without an interpreter *"... my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29) ,* it is impossible for Allah to speak directly to the Prophets.

Because Allah does not speak using speech or language like humans speak. Allah uses symbols.

Where those who understand the symbols of Allah are only *"... my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29) ,* because *"... My spirit...(Al Hijr: 15: 29)* is what comes directly from Allah. Allah is not the same as His creation in this universe.

Allah is Allah.

CONCLUSION

Based on the description above, we can conclude that the secret hidden behind the verse: *" Allah said: "O Moses, indeed I chose you and other humans to...to talk directly to Me..." (Al A'raaf : 7:144)*

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
