Musa said: "This is an act of Satan, indeed, Satan is an enemy who misleads and is real. (Al-Qasas: 28:15)

"Then We sent Musa after the apostles with Our verses to Pharaoh and the leaders of his people, and they denied them. So pay attention to what the consequences of those who make mischief are. (Al A'raaf: 7:103)

"Then both of you come to him and say: "Indeed, we are both messengers of your Lord, so let the Children of Israel be with us and do not torture them. Indeed, we have come to you with evidence from your Lord. And salvation is bestowed upon those who follow instructions. (Thaaha: 20:47)

"And when We parted the sea for you, then We saved you and We drowned you and your followers while you were watching. (Al Baqarah: 2:50)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about whether Prophet Musa led the struggle, the Jewish minority against the ruler of Pharaoh Merneptah I used the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that Prophet Musa led the struggle of the Jewish minority who were oppressed by the ruler of Pharaoh Merneptah from the basic point of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)
