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ABSTRACT

"Indeed I confront myself with the Lord who created the heavens and the earth, with an inclination to the true religion, and I am not one of those who associate partners with God. (Al An'aam: 6: 79)

"And when Abraham said to his father, Aazar, "Are you not supposed to make idols as gods? Verily, I see you and your people in clear error." (Al An'aam: 6:74)

"When his Lord said to him: "Submit, obey!" Ibrahim replied: "I submit obediently to the Lord of the worlds." (Al Baqarah: 2:131)

"And Ibrahim's request for forgiveness (to Allah) for his father was nothing but because of a promise he had made to his father. So, when it became clear to Ibrahim that his father was an enemy of Allah, Abraham dissociated himself from him. very soft-hearted and forgiving.(At Taubah: 9:114)

"And when Isa ibn Maryam said: "O Children of Israel, indeed I am the messenger of Allah to you, confirming the book before me, namely the Torah, and giving glad tidings of an Apostle who will come after me, whose name is Ahmad." So when the apostle came to they brought tangible evidence, they said: "This is real magic." (Ash Shaff: 61: 6)

Those to whom We have given the Book know Muhammad as they know their own children. And indeed some of them hide the truth, even though they know. (Al Baqarah: 2: 146)

"Indeed We have sent you with the truth; as a bearer of glad tidings and a warner, and you will not be asked about the inhabitants of Hell. (Al Baqarah: 2: 119)

"Then We revealed to you: "Follow the religion of Abraham, a hanif" and he is not one of those who associate partners with God (An Nahl: 16: 123)

"Say: "Indeed I was forbidden to worship what you worship besides Allah after revelations came to me from my Lord; and I was commanded to submit to the Lord of the worlds. (Al Mu'min: 40: 66)

"And it is not possible for a man of Allah to speak to him except by revelation or behind a veil or by sending an apostle, then it is revealed to him with His permission what He wills. Verily He is Most High., Most Wise. (Ash Shuura: 42:51)

"When I have perfected the event, and have breathed into it my spirit, then submit to it prostrating yourself (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

"So when I have perfected the show and breathed into it my skirt; then you must prostrate to him." (Shaad: 38:72)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

"Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing, sight, and heart; you are very little grateful." (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

In an effort to unmask Allah's secret about why Allah chose the Prophet from Arabia, no longer of Jewish descent, I used the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS
