

UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS,
HOW HUMANS RELY REPENT TO ALLAH

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ABSTRACT

Before I write down the problem of how humans actually repent to Allah, first I ask forgiveness from Allah SWT. Here I try to open the veil that covers the secret, how humans actually repent to Allah, from the point of view of the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

There are several verses that become Allah's secret unlocking tool about how humans actually repent to Allah, namely the verses:

"So when I have perfected the event, and have breathed into it my spirit, then submit to it prostrating yourself (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

"Indeed repentance with Allah is only repentance for those who do evil because of ignorance, and then they repent immediately, then they are the ones Allah accepts their repentance for; and Allah is Knowing, All-Wise. (An Nisaa ': 4:17)

"Except those who have repented and made amends and explained, then against them I accept their repentance and I am the Most Accepting of repentance, Most Merciful. (Baqarah: 2:160)

"And those who repent and do righteous deeds, then indeed they repent to Allah with true repentance." (Al-Furqaan: 25:71)

"So stay on the right path, as you were commanded and those who have repented are with you and do not transgress. Indeed, He is All-Seer of what you do. (Huud: 11:112)

"Except for those who repent and make amends and hold fast to Allah and are sincere in their religion for the sake of Allah. Then they are together with those who believe and in the future Allah will give those who believe a great reward. (Ann) Nisa' : 4: 146)

"Those who do evil, then repent after that and believe; verily your Lord after repentance accompanied by faith is Most Forgiving, Most Merciful. (Al A'raaf: 7:153)

"So glorify your Lord and ask forgiveness of Him. Indeed, He is the Most Accepting of repentance." (An Nasr: 110: 3)

"O you who believe, repent to Allah with repentance nasuhaa. Hopefully your Lord will cover your mistakes and admit you to Jannah under which rivers flow, on the day when Allah will not humiliate the Prophet and the believers who with him, while their light shines before and on their right, while they say: "Our Lord, perfect for us our light and forgive us; Verily, You have power over all things." (At Tahrir: 66: 8)

"So if they do not answer, know that they are only following their desires. And who is more astray than those who follow their desires without getting any guidance from Allah. Verily, Allah does not guide the wrongdoers. (Al-Qasas) :28:50)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about how humans actually repent to Allah, I use the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that humans repent to Allah after humans *"...do evil, then repent after that and believe..." (Al A'raaf: 7: 153)* seen from the basic point of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that form a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules arranged in repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine(A), Cytocine(C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) is composed of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 atom oxygen and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms, 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5 carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

HUMANS DO CRIME BECAUSE OF IGNORITY

Now, we are still trying to focus our minds to open the secrets stored in the verse: *"... repentance with Allah is only repentance for those who do crime because of ignorance, which they repent immediately..." (An Nisaa ' : 4:17)*

It turns out that ignorance is the source of crime.

Now, the question arises,

How does one commit a crime, out of ignorance or ignorance?

The answer is

Hidden in the secret behind the verse: *"... I have breathed into it my spirit..." (Al Hijr: 15: 29)* *"... perfect for us our light and forgive us..." (At Tahrim: 66: 8)*

It turns out, the stupidity that occurs, is the result of *"... my spirit..." (Al Hijr: 15: 29)* which is in the human body, does not emit *"... light ..." (At Tahrim: 66: 8)*

Because *"... my spirit..." (Al Hijr: 15: 29)* does not emit *"...light..." (At Tahrim: 66: 8)*, ignorance arises.

It means, *"... my spirit..." (Al Hijr: 15: 29)* has no knowledge about actions that lead to crime.

Or in other words, *"... my spirit..." (Al Hijr: 15: 29)* which is in the human body does not receive the knowledge of crime, or humans are still stupid and do not know the behavior that leads to crime behavior.

HUMANS WHO DON'T KNOW THE BEHAVIOR THAT LEAD TO CRIME

Now, then, we will reveal the secret behind the verse: *"...repent for those who do crime because of ignorance, which then they repent immediately...(An Nisaa ' : 4: 17)*

Apparently, if a person commits a crime because of *"...my spirit..." (Al Hijr: 15: 29)* which is in that

person's body does not receive the knowledge of crime, then he immediately repents, *"...then they are the ones who Allah accepts his repentance...(An Nisaa ' : 4: 17)*

Now, the question arises

How do we know, that person has no knowledge of behavior that leads to crime, even though he is committing a crime?

The answer is

Hidden in the secret behind the verse: *"...they only follow their desires... (Al Qashash: 28: 50)*

So, the crime committed by someone because it is based on *"...lust... (Al Qashash: 28: 50)*

So, the impulse *"... lust... (Al Qashash: 28: 50)* is what is included in *"... ignorance... (An Nisaa ' : 4: 17)*

REPENT BASED ON FAITH, TRUST IN ALLAH, GOOD ACTIVITIES, DO NOT EXCEED LIMITATIONS

So onwards, a person who commits a crime, then repents, continues with *"...faithful... (Al A'raaf: 7:153) "...doing good deeds...(Al Furqaan: 25:71)" ...hold fast to Allah...(An Nisaa' : 4: 146) "...do not...go beyond the limits...(Huud : 11:112) "...then verily he repents to Allah with true repentance (Al Furqaan: 25:71)*

Or in other words, a person who commits a crime, then *"...repent...to Allah with repentance nasuhaa... (At Tahrir: 66: 8)* meaning, repentance that is truly pure. *"...Hopefully your Lord will cover your faults and admit you to Jannah under which rivers flow...(At Tahrir: 66: 8)*

Now, it has been revealed, the secret hidden behind the verse: *"... repentance for those who do crime because of ignorance, which then they repent immediately... (An Nisaa ' : 4:17)*

A person commits a crime because *"... my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29)* which is in the person's body does not get the knowledge of crime, then he immediately repents, *"... then it is they whom Allah accepts repentance ...(An Nisaa' : 4:17)*

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CONCLUSION

Based on the description above, we can conclude that the secrets stored in the verse: *"... repentance with Allah is only repentance for those who do crime because of ignorance, which they repent immediately... (An Nisaa ' : 4:17)*

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
