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ABSTRACT

Before I write down the problem of humans being able to study how Allah thinks, because there is a balance of thinking between Allah and humans, I first ask forgiveness from Allah SWT. "Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing, sight and heart; you are very little grateful. (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

"And if We made the apostle an angel, We would certainly have made him a man and, of course We would have doubted about them what they doubted about themselves (Al An'aam: 6:9)

"And it is not possible for any human being that Allah can speak with him except by means of revelation or behind a veil or by sending a messenger and then it is revealed to him with His permission what He wills. Verily, He is Most High, Most Wise. (Ash Shuura: 42: 51)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

"And when My servants ask you about Me, then, that I am near. I grant the supplication of those who pray when he asks Me, then let them fulfill and let them believe in Me, so that they will always be in truth.(Al Bagarah: 2:186)

"Angels and spirits descend with the permission of their Lord to manage all affairs (Al Qadr: 97: 4)

"And they ask you about the spirit. Say: "The spirit belongs to my Lord, and knowledge is not given to you but a little." (Al Israa': 17: 85)

"And there is no power of the devil over them, but only that We may distinguish those who believe in the existence of the Hereafter from those who doubt about it. And your Lord is the Preserver of all things. (Saba': 34:21)

"And if We wish, We have indeed made in your place on earth angels that have been passed down from generation to generation. (Az Zukhruf: 43:60)

Say: "He is Allah, the One and Only. (Al Ikhlash: 112: 1)

"Say: "I seek refuge in the Lord Who is in control of the dawn (Al Falaq: 113: 1)

Say: "I take refuge in the God of mankind. (An-Naas: 114:1)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about humans being able to learn how Allah thinks, because there is a balance of thinking between Allah and humans, I use the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that humans think Allah thinks the same as humans think, because there is a balance of thinking between Allah and humans, based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

PHOTON

DEOXYRIBONUCLIC ACID (DNA)

This nucleotide consists of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine (A), Cytosine (C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) consists of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytosine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms. 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. A 5-carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

Based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) humans are composed of 32.20% atoms carbon, 25.43% nitrogen atoms, 6.78% oxygen atoms and 35.59% hydrogen atoms. Where carbon, nitrogen, oxygen and hydrogen atoms are widely available around us and in atmosphere.

Now, we are still concentrating on uncovering the secrets contained behind the verses: "...they ask you about the spirit. (Al Ikhlash: 112: 1)" Say: "I seek refuge in the Lord Who is in control of the dawn (Al Falaq: 113: 1)" Say: "I seek refuge in the Lord of mankind. (An-Naas: 114:1)

Apparently, here Allah has declared, that how Allah thinks is in balance with how humans think.

How can it be that Allah thinks the same way humans think?

The answer is

Hidden in the secret behind the verse: "Say: "I seek refuge in the God of mankind. (An-Naas: 114: 1)"...Say: "The spirit belongs to my Lord's property...(Al Israa': 17:85)

Well, here Allah has made how Allah thinks the same as how the Prophet Muhammad saw thought "...Say: "The spirit belongs to my Lord's property...(Al Israa': 17: 85)" Say: "I seek refuge in the God of mankind. (An-Naas: 114:1)

With Allah commanding the Prophet Muhammad SAW to say "The spirit belongs to my Lord's

property ... (Al Israa ': 17: 85) "I take refuge in the God of mankind. (An-Naas: 114:1)

This proves that there is a balance of thought between Allah and the Prophet Muhammad saw.

So, how Allah thinks is reflected by how Prophet Muhammad saw thought.

Or in other words, what the Prophet Muhammad saw said is a reflection of what Allah thinks and says.

HUMANS LEARN HOW ALLAH THINKING, SO HUMANS UNDERSTAND WHO ALLAH AND HOW ALLAH IS

Humans will not know how Allah thinks, if not through what is reflected by the Prophet Muhammad saw "...Say: "The spirit belongs to my Lord's property...(Al Israa': 17: 85) "I seek refuge in the God of mankind. (An-Naas: 114:1)
