In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about in what matters, which makes between Allah and humans balanced, I use the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) humans are composed of 32.20% atoms carbon, 25.43% nitrogen atoms, 6.78% oxygen atoms and 35.59% hydrogen atoms. Where carbon, nitrogen, oxygen and hydrogen atoms are widely available around us and in atmosphere.
