Say: "Shall I seek a god besides Allah, when He is Lord of all things? And no one commits sin except that his harm returns to himself; and a sinner will not bear the sins of another. Then to your Lord you will return, and He will inform you of what you disagreed with." (Al An'am: 6:164)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about whether it is true, some followers of Jesus still believe that Adam inherited sin to other humans, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

#### **HYPOTHESIS**
