UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS, MOST PEOPLE STILL BELIEVE THAT HUMANS WILL MEET ALLAH WHEN HUMANS DIE, WHILE ALLAH IS EVERY TIME IN THE HUMAN BODY

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ABSTRACT

The Lord said: "You will never be able to see Me, but look at the mountain, then if it stays where it is you will surely see me." When his Lord appeared to the mountain, he made the mountain crumble and Moses fell unconscious. So when Moses regained consciousness, he said: "Glory be to him. You, I repent to You and I am the first to believe." (Al A'raaf: 7:143)

"And We made before them a wall and behind them a wall, and We covered them so that they could not see." (Yaasiin: 36:9)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about most people still believe that humans will meet Allah when humans die, even though Allah is always in the human body, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) humans are composed of 32.20% atoms carbon, 25.43% nitrogen atoms, 6.78% oxygen atoms and 35.59% hydrogen atoms. Where carbon, nitrogen, oxygen and hydrogen atoms are widely available around us and in atmosphere.
