"Forbidden to you is carrion, blood, pork, which is slaughtered in the name of other than Allah, the strangled, the beaten, the fallen, the gored, and the wild beast devoured, except for those that you had time to slaughter, and which were slaughtered for idols. And draw your fate with arrows are iniquity. This day the disbelievers have given up on your religion, so do not fear them and fear Me. This day I have perfected your religion for you, and have completed My favor upon you, and have approved Islam be a religion for you. So whoever is compelled by hunger to commit a sin, verily, Allah is Most Forgiving, Most Merciful (Al Maa'idah 5:3)

"Who has created the seven heavens in layers. You do not see in the creation of the Most Gracious God anything that is not balanced. So look over and over again, do you see anything that is not balanced? (Al Mulk: 67: 3)

In an effort to open the veil of the secret about on what basis, Allah forbids animals, which are slaughtered without mentioning Allah, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here the author proposes the hypothes Allah forbids animals, which are slaughtered without

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that form a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules arranged in repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine(A), Cytocine(C) and Thymine (T).
