In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about the Sufism people having difficulty finding Allah, so they have to cross the Red Sea, to reach Palestine, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.
