*"And when you say to the one whom Allah has bestowed favors upon him and you have bestowed upon him: "Hold on to your wife and fear Allah", while you hide in your hearts what Allah will reveal, and you fear people, while Allah - who has more right for you to fear. So when Zaid had finished the need for his wife, We married you to him so that there would be no objection for the believers for the wives of their adopted children, if the adopted children had completed their needs from their wives. And it is God's decree that it will happen. (Al Ahzab: 33: 37)*

In an effort to open the veil about, is it true that until the end of the world, men will not be able to do justice to their wives, I based on photons, quarks and deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.
