

UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS, WHY ALLAH TOLD HUMANS TO CHANGE FATE

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ABSTRACT

First of all, by asking forgiveness from Allah SWT here I try to reveal the signs of Allah SWT's greatness regarding Allah's secret about why Allah told humans to change fate, based on photons, quarks and the molecular structure of nucleic acids or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

"And do they not see that Allah expands sustenance for whom He wills and He narrows it. Verily in that are signs for a people who believe. (Ar Ruum: 30: 37)

"It is He Who shows you His signs and sends down for you sustenance from the sky. And there is no lesson except those who return (to Allah). (Al Mu'min: 40:13)

"The people of Moses said: We were oppressed before you came to us and after you came. Musa replied: "Hopefully Allah will destroy your enemies and make you vicegerents on earth, then Allah will see how you do. (Al A'raaf: 7:129)

"...Indeed, Allah does not change the condition of a people until they change what is in themselves... (Ar Ra'd: 13:11)

"Those are the inhabitants of Paradise, they will abide in it forever; as a reward for what they have done. (Al Ahqaaf: 46:14)

Lord "When his Lord said to him: "Bow down, obey!" Ibrahim replied: "I submit obediently to the of the worlds." (Al Baqarah: 2:131)

"Indeed, in the creation of the heavens and the earth, the alternation of night and day, the ark that sailed on the sea brought what was useful to mankind, and what Allah sent down from the sky was water, and with it He gave life to the earth after its death and spread it over the land. the earth is all kinds of animals, and the movement of the winds and clouds is controlled between the heavens and the earth, indeed signs for a people who think (Al Baqarah: 2: 164)

"O congregation of jinn and humans, if you are able to penetrate the corners of the heavens and the earth, then cross it, you cannot penetrate it except with a sulthon. (Ar Rahmaan: 55: 33)

In an attempt to unmask Allah's secret about why Allah told humans to change fate, I based on photons, quarks and deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that Allah told humans to change fate, because human fate is not determined by Allah, based on photons, quarks and deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5 carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine (A), Cytocine (C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) is composed of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms, 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5 carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

WHAT HUMANS CANNOT CHANGE

Now, we are still concentrating on uncovering the secrets that are hidden behind the verse: *"Indeed, in the creation of the heavens and the earth, the alternation of night and day, the ark that sailed on the sea brought what was useful to humans, and what Allah sent down from the sky was in the form of water, then with it He gives life to the earth after its death and He spreads on the earth all kinds of animals, and the movement of winds and clouds that are controlled between the heavens and the earth... (Al Baqarah: 2:164)*

It turns out, now revealed, that no matter how smart humans are, it would be impossible to change *"...the creation of the heavens and the earth, the alternation of night and day, the ark that sailed on the sea carrying what was useful to humans, and what Allah sent down from the sky. in the form of water ... (Al Baqarah: 2: 164)*

It is also impossible for humans to change *"...with the water He gives life to the earth after its death and He spreads on the earth all kinds of animals, and the spreading of the winds and clouds that are controlled between the heavens and the earth... (Al Baqarah: 2:164)*

Now, all that concerns the laws of nature, which are natural laws that have been ordained by Allah, it is impossible for humans to change them.

Likewise, Allah's decree has been outlined in the verse: *"They are the residents of Paradise, they will abide in it forever; as a reward for what they have done. (Al Ahqaaf: 46:14)*

Now the people who will become *"... the residents of paradise, they will stay in it... (Al Ahqaaf: 46:14)* is predetermined *"...the reward for what they have done. (Al Ahqaaf: 46:14)* With the condition *"Bow down obey!"... (Al Baqarah: 2: 131)*

HUMANS CAN CHANGE FATE

Now, let's unpack the secret that is hidden behind the verse: *"...Indeed, Allah does not change the condition of a people until they change the situation that is in themselves... (Ar Ra'd: 13: 11)*

It turns out that, in terms of situations, circumstances, fate and destiny concerning human life and the surrounding community, humans are given the freedom to change situations, circumstances, fate and destiny.

Why does Allah command humans to change situations, circumstances, fate and destiny concerning human life and the surrounding community?

The answer is

Hidden behind the secret of the verse: *"...Indeed Allah does not change the condition of a people until they change the situation that is in themselves... (Ar Ra'd: 13:11)* and the verse: *"And seek in what has been bestowed Allah to you the land of the hereafter, and do not forget your share of the worldly... (Al Qashash: 28: 77)*

Apparently, here Allah has declared to humans: *"... Allah does not change the condition of a people until they change the situation that is in themselves ... (Ar Ra'd: 13: 11) "... look for what is Allah has bestowed upon you the land of the hereafter, and do not forget your share of the worldly... (Al-Qasash: 28: 77)*

So humans are ordered by Allah to change the situation, circumstances, fate and destiny that concerns human life and the surrounding community, so that human life becomes balanced between life in this world and in the hereafter.

KNOWLEDGE ONE OF THE TOOLS TO CHANGE FATE

So onwards, we will uncover the secret behind the verse: *"O congregation of jinn and humans, if you are able to penetrate the corners of the heavens and the earth, then cross it, you cannot penetrate it except with the sulthon. (Ar Rahmaan: 55: 33)*

Apparently, Allah has declared, not only to humans, but also to the jinn, to study the universe created by Allah, through *"...sulthon. (Ar Rahman: 55: 33)*

Well it means *"...sulthon. (Ar Rahmaan: 55: 33)* here is knowledge.

So to change the situation, circumstances, fate and destiny concerning human life and the surrounding community, one of them is knowledge.

Or in other words, to change the situation, circumstances, fate and destiny that concerns human life and the surrounding community is to seek knowledge, either through school or through experience.
