*"And to the people of Mad-yan, their brother Shu'aib, he said: "O my people, worship Allah, hope for the last day, and do not roam the earth doing mischief." (Al 'Ankabuut: 29:36)*

*"They killed the camel, then said Salih: "Rejoice all of you in your homes for three days, that is a promise that cannot be denied." (Huud: 11:65)*

*"And when Our messengers came to Lut, he felt troubled and felt his chest narrow because of their arrival, and he said: "This is a very difficult day (Huud: 11: 77)*

*"And to the people of 'Ad their brother Huud. He said: "O my people, worship Allah, there is absolutely no god for you but Him. You are just fabricating it. (Huud: 11: 50)*

*"And tell about Idris in the Quran. Indeed he is a very justified and a prophet. (Maryam: 19:56)*

*"O Children of Israel, remember My favor which I have bestowed upon you, and fulfill your promise to Me, I will certainly fulfill My promise to you; and only me should you fear. (Al Baqarah: 2:40)*

*And when Isa ibn Maryam said: "O Children of Israel, indeed I am the messenger of Allah to you, confirming the book before me, namely the Torah, and giving glad tidings of an Apostle who will come after me, whose name is Ahmad." So when the apostle came to them with clear evidence, they said: "This is real magic." (Ash Shaff : 61: 6)*

*"...Today I have perfected your religion for you, and have completed My favor upon you, and have approved Islam as a religion for you...(Al Maa'idah: 5:3)*

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about why almost 99% of the Prophets chosen by Allah are Jews, but the teachings of the hereafter, paradise and hell are not in their books, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids. .

## **HYPOTHESIS**

Here the author proposes the hypothesis that almost 99% of the Prophets chosen by Allah were Jews, but the teachings about the hereafter, paradise and hell are not in their books, based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

## **DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)**

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that form a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules arranged in repeatedly from nucleotide polymers.
