"So when I have perfected the event and have breathed into it my spirit; then you should fall down prostrating to him." (Shaad: 38: 72)

"And We put before them a wall and behind them a wall, and We covered them so that they could not see. (Yaasiin: 36: 9)

"Allah is the light of the heavens and the earth...Light upon light (An Nuur: 24:35)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

In an attempt to unmask Allah's secret about why angels, when they meet humans, do not want to eat human food, I use the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.
