UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS, WHY HIDAYAH SHOULD BE SEEK AND ASKED OF ALLAH, HIDAYAH DOES NOT COME BY ITS OWN

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ABSTRACT

"And indeed We have bestowed on Ibrahim the guidance of the truth before (Moses) and We knew it. (Al Anbiyaa': 21: 51)

"Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing, sight and hearts; you are very little grateful. (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

"And when My servants ask you about Me, then, that I am near. I grant the supplication of those who pray when he asks Me, then let them fulfill and let them believe in Me, so that they will always be in truth. (Al Baqarah: 2:186)

"He arranges affairs from the heavens to the earth, then they ascend to Him in one day whose measure is a thousand years according to your reckoning (As Sajdah: 32: 5)

"Angels and spirits ascend to God in a day whose measure is fifty thousand years." (Al Ma'aarij: 70:4)

"Who has created the seven heavens in layers. You do not see in the creation of the Most Gracious God anything that is not balanced. So look over and over again, do you see anything that is not balanced? (Al Mulk: 67: 3)

"And to Allah belongs the east and the west, so wherever you turn there is the face of Allah. Verily Allah is All-Wise, All-Knowing. (Al Baqarah: 2:115)

"And they ask you about the spirit. Say: "The spirit belongs to my Lord, and knowledge is not given to you but a little." (Al Israa': 17: 85)

"And when Moses came for an appointed time and the Lord had spoken to him, Moses said, "My Lord, show me that I may see You." The Lord said: "You will never be able to see Me, but look at the mountain, then if it stays where it is you will surely see me." You, I repent to You and I am the first to believe." (Al A'raaf: 7:143)

"When the night was dark, he saw a star he said: "This is my Lord", but when the star set he said: "I do not like the sinking." (Al An'aam: 6: 76)

"Then when he saw the moon rising he said: "This is my Lord." But after the moon had set, he said: "If my Lord had not guided me, I would have been one of those who went astray." (Al An'aam: 6:77)

"Then when he saw the sun rising, he said: "This is my Lord, this is greater." So when the sun was setting, he said: "O my people, indeed I am free from what you associate with. (Al An'aam: 6:78)

"When his Lord said to him: "Submit obediently!" Ibrahim replied: "I submit obediently to the Lord of the worlds". (Al Bagarah: 2:131)

"And when Abraham said to his father, Aazar, "Do you have to make idols as gods? Verily I see you and your people in clear error." (Al An'aam: 6:74)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about why hidayah or guidance must be sought and asked from Allah, hidayah or guidance does not come by itself, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS
