UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS, WHY HUMANS SHOULD FIRST UNDERSTAND ALLAH BEFORE LEARNING ALLAH'S TEACHINGS

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ABSTRACT

Before the author writes the problem of why humans must first understand Allah, before studying Allah's teachings, the author first asks forgiveness from Allah SWT. Here the author tries to open the veil that covers the secret of why humans must first understand Allah, before studying Allah's teachings, based on the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

There are several verses that reveal Allah's secrets aboutwhy humans must first understand Allah, before studying Allah's teachings, namely the following verses:

"So when I have perfected the event and have breathed into it my spirit; then you should fall down prostrating to him." (Shaad: 38: 72)

"So when I have perfected the event, and have breathed into it my spirit, then submit to it prostrating yourself (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

"Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing, sight and hearts; you are very little grateful. (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

"And it is not possible for any human being that Allah can speak with him except by means of revelation or behind a veil or by sending a messenger and then it is revealed to him with His permission what He wills. Verily, He is Most High, Most Wise. (Ash Shuura: 42: 51)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

"So he put a veil from them; then We sent our spirit to him, and he appeared before him a perfect human being. (Maryam: 19:17)

"And when My servants ask you about Me, then, that I am near. I grant the supplication of those who pray when he asks Me, then let them fulfill and let them believe in Me, so that they will always be in truth.(Al Baqarah: 2:186)

"He is the First and the Last, the Outward and the Inward; and He is All-Knowing of all things. (Al Hadid: 57:3)

"He arranges affairs from the skys to the earth, then they ascend to Him in one day whose measure is a thousand years according to your reckoning (As Sajdah: 32: 5)

"Angels and spirits ascend to God in a day whose measure is fifty thousand years." (Al Ma'aarij: 70:4)

"Who has created the seven skys in layers. You do not see in the creation of the Most Gracious God anything that is not balanced. So look over and over again, do you see anything that is not balanced? (Al Mulk: 67: 3)

"And to Allah belongs the east and the west, so wherever you turn there is the face of Allah. Verily Allah is All-Wise, All-Knowing. (Al Baqarah: 2:115)

"And they ask you about the spirit. Say: "The spirit belongs to my God, and knowledge is not given to you but a little." (Al Israa ': 17: 85)

"Read in the name of your God Who created (Al 'Alaq: 96: 1)

"He has created man from a clot of blood. (Al 'Alaq: 96:2)

"And thus We showed Abraham the signs of majesty in the skys and the earth and that he might be of those who believe. (Al An'aam: 6:75)

"When the night was dark, he saw a star he said: "This is my God", but when the star set he said: "I do not like the sinking." (Al An'aam: 6: 76)

"Then when he saw the moon rising he said: "This is my God." But after the moon had set, he said: "If my God had not guided me, I would have been one of those who went astray." (Al An'aam: 6:77))

"Then when he saw the sun rising, he said: "This is my God, this is greater." So when the sun was setting, he said: "O my people, indeed I am free from what you associate with. (Al An'aam: 6:78)

"When his Lord said to him: "Submit obediently!" Ibrahim replied: "I submit obediently to the Lord of the worlds". (Al Baqarah: 2:131)

"And when Abraham said to his father, Aazar, "Do you have to make idols as gods? Verily I see you and your people in clear error." (Al An'aam: 6:74)

"And when Abraham said: "O my Lord, show me how You bring the dead to life." Allah said: "Are you not convinced yet?" Ibrahim replied: "I have convinced him, but so that my heart remains steady Allah said: "Take four tails of birds, then chop them all up by you. "Then put on each hill one part of the parts, then call them, surely they will come to you immediately." And know that Allah is Mighty, Most Wise. (Al Baqarah : 2:260)

"And We made before them a wall and behind them a wall, and We covered them so that they could not see." (Yaasiin: 36:9)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about why humans must first understand Allah, before studying Allah's teachings, the author uses the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here the author proposes a hypothesis after humans understand Allah, it will be easy to learn Allah's teachings, based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

PHOTON

Photons are elementary particles of the boson type and carriers of electromagnetic interactions.

QUARK

If we want to know quarks, then we consider one of the hydrogen atoms that is the building block of the human body, animals, plants and fruits and inanimate objects. Then we open the body of the hydrogen atom, we will find one electron and one proton nucleus. Then if this proton is split, then we will find two up quarks and one down quark. Where these three quarks are combined with gluons.

DEOXYRIBONUCLIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that forms a double helix and contains polynucleotide macromolecules that are arranged repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide consists of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine (A), Cytosine (C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) consists of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytosine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms. 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. A 5-carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms.

Based on Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) humans are composed of 32.20% atoms carbon, 25.43% nitrogen atoms, 6.78% oxygen atoms and 35.59% hydrogen atoms. Where carbon, nitrogen, oxygen and hydrogen atoms are widely available around us and in atmosphere.

WHY HUMANS SHOULD FIRST UNDERSTAND ALLAH BEFORE LEARNING ALLAH'S TEACHINGS

Now, we are still focusing our minds on uncovering the secrets contained behind the verses: "Read in the name of your God Who created (Al 'Alaq: 96: 1)"...created man from a clot of blood (Al 'Alaq: 96: 1). 2)"...he saw a star he said: "This is my Lord"...(Al An'aam: 6:76) "...he saw the moon rising he said: "This is my God"...(Al An'aam: 6:77)"...he saw the sun rising, he said: "This is my God...(Al An'aam: 6:78)"...His God said to him: "Be obedient!" Ibrahim replied: "I submit to the God of the worlds." (Al Baqarah: 2:131)

Apparently, here Allah has declared "Read in the name of your God Who created (Al 'Alaq: 96: 1)"...he saw a star he said: "This is my God"...(Al An'aam: 6: 76) "...he saw the rising moon he said: "This is my God"...(Al An'aam: 6:77)"...he saw the sun rising, he said: "This is my God...(Al An'am: 6:78)

Now the question arises,

Why did Allah declare with "Read in the name of your God Who created (Al 'Alaq: 96: 1) ?

The answer is in the secret behind the verse: "... We showed Abraham signs of majesty in the skys and the earth... (Al An'aam: 6: 75)

Well, "...the signs of majesty in the skys and the earth...(Al An'aam: 6:75) were the first to be shown and taught by Allah to the youth of Abraham.

What are "...signs of majesty in the skys and the earth...(Al An'aam: 6:75) ?

The answer is stored in the verse: "...stars...(Al An'aam: 6: 76)"...moon...(Al An'aam: 6: 77)"...sun... (Al An'aam: 6:78)

Well, "...stars...(Al An'aam: 6:76)"...moon...(Al An'aam: 6:77)"...sun...(Al An' aam: 6:78) is Allah's creation.

Now, when the youth of Ibrahim has understood about who created the "...stars...(Al An'aam: 6: 76)"...the moon...(Al An'aam: 6: 77)"...sun ... (Al An'aam: 6: 78), then when Allah "...says to him: "Submit obediently!" Ibrahim replied: "I submit obediently to the Lord of the worlds" (Al Baqarah: 2:131)

Well, here clearly, Allah reveals the secret of Allah, namely that first humans must understand the real Allah, before studying Allah's teachings, as did the youth of Abraham, when the youth of Abraham was looking for Allah or Jahve according to the call of the Jews and followers of Jesus.

Or in other words Allah "...Who created (Al 'Alaq: 96: 1) the seven skys and all their contents, including humans, animals, plants, arkae, amoeba, bacteria, fungi and whatever objects are in the seven skys.

Now, after understanding the real Allah, then humans learn Allah's teachings, Allah "...said to him: "Be obedient!" Ibrahim replied: "I submit obediently to God of the worlds" (Al Baqarah: 2:131)

So, as a Muslim, the first thing to understand is the real Allah. After that, only learn what has been revealed to the Prophet Muhammad saw, which is stored in the Qur'an.
