"And give good tidings to those who believe and do good, that for them there are provided gardens with rivers flowing in them. Every time they are given sustenance of fruit in those paradises, they say: "This is what was given to them. us first." They are given similar fruits and for them are pure wives and they will abide therein (Al Baqarah: 2:25)
