UNLOCKING ALLAH'S SECRETS, WITH WHAT REASONS, DEAD PEOPLE CONSIDERED SACRED

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ABSTRACT

Before I write down the problem, for what reason, dead people are considered sacred, first I ask forgiveness from Allah SWT. Here I try to open the veil that covers the secret, for what reason, the dead are considered sacred, from the point of the molecular structure of nucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA).

There are several verses that become God's secret unlocking tool about for what reason, the dead are considered sacred, namely the verses:

"So when I have perfected the event and have breathed into it my spirit; then you should fall down prostrating to him." (Shaad: 38: 72)

"Allah is the light of the skys and the earth...Light upon light...(An Nuur: 24: 35)

"So when I have perfected the event, and have breathed into it my spirit, then submit to it prostrating yourself (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

"... Jesus, the son of Mary, is the messenger of Allah and His words which He conveyed to Mary, and a spirit from Him... (An Nisaa ': 4: 171)

"Allah holds the soul when it dies and the soul that has not died in its sleep; so He holds the soul which He has appointed death and He releases another soul until the appointed time. Verily in that are the signs of Allah's power for a people who think (Az Zumar: 39: 42)

"Have you not seen that Allah has subjected to you what is in the heavens and what is in the earth and has perfected for you His blessings both outwardly and inwardly. And among mankind there are those who dispute about Allah without knowledge or guidance and without an enlightening Book. (Luqman: 31:20)

"Then He put him to death and put him in the grave ('Abasa: 80:21)

"And Who sends down water from the sky according to the degree, then We bring to life with it a dead land, just like that you will be expelled (Az Zukhruf: 43:11)

"And verily the Day of Resurrection will surely come, there is no doubt about it, and that Allah will raise up all those in the graves." (Al Hajj: 22:7)

"And verily We have created man and know what his heart whispers, and We are nearer to him than his jugular vein." (Qaf: 50:16)

"Allah has sealed their hearts and their hearings, and their eyesight is closed. And for them is a very severe torment (Al Baqarah: 2: 7)

"And they ask you about the spirit. Say: "The spirit belongs to my Lord, and knowledge is not given to you but a little." (Al Israa': 17: 85)

"Then He perfected and breathed into it His spirit and He made for you hearing and sight and hearts; you are very grateful. (As Sajdah: 32: 9)

In an effort to open the veil of Allah's secret about why, the dead are considered sacred, I use the basis of deoxyribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid or the molecular structure of nucleic acids.

HYPOTHESIS

Here I propose the hypothesis that the dead are considered sacred, because humans do not understand "... my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29), viewed from the basic point of Deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA)

DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID (DNA)

DNA is a repository of genetic information that has a double structure that form a double helix and which contains polynucleotide macromolecules arranged in repeatedly from nucleotide polymers. This nucleotide is composed of folate, a 5-carbon sugar and one of the nitrogenous bases. The nitrogenous bases are Guanine (G), Adenine(A), Cytocine(C) and Thymine (T).

Guanine (G) is composed of 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms, 1 atom oxygen and 5 hydrogen atoms. Adenine(A) has 5 carbon atoms, 5 nitrogen atoms and 5 hydrogen atoms. Cytocine (C) contains 4 carbon atoms, 3 nitrogen atoms, 1 oxygen atom and 5 hydrogen atoms. Thymine (T) contains 5 carbon atoms. 2 nitrogen atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 6 hydrogen atoms. Folate contains 1 phosphorus atom, 4 oxygen atoms and 2 hydrogen atoms. The 5 carbon sugar has 5 carbon atoms, 2 oxygen atoms and 8 hydrogen atoms.

DEAD PEOPLE CONSIDERED SACRED BY SOME HUMANS

Now, we are still trying to concentrate our minds in order to reveal the secret contained behind the verse: "Then He put him to death and put him in the grave ('Abasa: 80: 21)

Apparently, here Allah has described that humans who have "Allah holds the soul when he dies ... He holds the soul that He has determined his death to be ... (Az Zumar: 39: 42) Then humans who are still alive, bury the dead.

Now the question arises,

Why do some people consider the dead to be sacred, so people flock to their graves to ask for protection and guidance from the dead and are considered sacred?

The answer is,

Hidden in the secret behind the verse: "Allah has sealed their hearts and ears, and their eyesight is closed... (Al Baqarah: 2: 7)

Well, apparently, Allah has closed the way of thinking and the view of the human eye, which should be used to understand about "... I... have breathed into it my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29) "Allah is the light of the sky and earth...Light upon light...(An Nuur: 24: 35)

It turns out, now revealed, why some people go to the graves of the dead who are considered sacred to ask for blessings and protection.

Because some of these people do not use their minds to learn what is called "... my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

All living things that exist in this world, are the same, where in their bodies, there is "... my spirit...

(Al Hijr: 15: 29)

So, if someone considers a dead person to be sacred, that is a sign that that person does not understand "... my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29)

Also with the reason "... The spirit belongs to my Lord's business, and you are not given knowledge but a little." (Al Israa': 17: 85)

Well, what the person does not understand is "...you were not given knowledge but a little." (Al Israa': 17: 85)

That is, humans are given knowledge of the spirit, even if only "...a little." (Al Israa': 17: 85)

Well, "... a little." (Al Israa': 17: 85) knowledge according to Allah, but if it is calculated and studied by humans, it is "... knowledge... little." (Al Israa': 17: 85) is an infinite number according to human calculations and views.

So, there is no reason for humans not to study and not explore "... my spirit... (Al Hijr: 15: 29)
